

“ALBEROBELLO VALLEY OF TRULLI & CASTELLANA CAVES”

(ONE DAY)

ALBEROBELLO CITY

Entering the Itria Valley you will find yourself a place called Alberobello. Also known as Valle dei trulli, thanks to the presence of Trulli, the trulli, rural architectural structures made of stone, are so numerous that they dominate the landscape. Alberobello is certainly a very important stop to make when you go to Puglia. The reason? Alberobello (thanks to the presence of the trulli) in 1996 has become a world heritage UNESCO. Going to the historic center is equivalent to immersing yourself in a place where time seems to have stopped. Think that in the oldest neighborhoods it is still possible to see some Trulli that are still inhabited, you will also find typical shops and shops where you can buy souvenirs and taste the typical products of the area.

CASTELLANA CAVES

The Castellana Caves, a complex of underground cavities of karst origin, of considerable tourist interest, among the most beautiful and spectacular in Italy, are located in the Municipality of Castellana-Grotte, about 1.5 km from the town. They extend for a length of 3348 meters and reach a maximum depth of 122 meters from the surface. The temperature of the internal environments is about 16.5 °C.

Located at the gates of the Itria Valley, a few kilometers from enchanting villages such as Alberobello, Cisternino, Polignano a Mare, the Castellana Caves open in the south-eastern Murge at 330 m above sea level on the limestone plateau formed in the Upper Cretaceous, about ninety-nine hundred million years ago.

The beauty of the Castellana Caves attracts visitors from all over the world, and since the day they opened to the public, more than 15 million people have walked its underground passages. The visit to the Caves winds along a 3 km path: an extraordinary guided excursion, about 70 meters deep, in an astonishing setting, where caves with fantastic names, canyons, deep abysses, fossils, stalactites, stalagmites, concretions with incredible shapes and surprising colors stimulate the imagination of children and adults.

Tour program

1. Departure at 07.00 for your accommodation to Castellana Caves with arrival at 11.00/11.30 am;
2. visit to the cave scheduled for 12.00;
3. free lunch or we recommend some restaurant in the area or near the caves or in the trulli of the city of Alberobello
4. visit to the trulli of Alberobello

5. departure from Alberobello is scheduled for 04.30/ 5.00 pm and return to the hotel around at 8.00/08.30 pm;
